



# NSW Immigration Deposits Combined Index 1853-1900

**PASTKEYS** publication of this completely revised and expanded NSW IMMIGRATION DEPOSITS COMBINED INDEX 1853-1900 is a *field-searchable* database on CD-ROM.

This version combines the two indexes – the *NSW Immigration Deposit Journals Index 1853-1900* and the *Immigration Deposit Regulations Supplementary Index 1856-1857* – and it has many new features. It now contains 71,211 records. These new features are:

- The duplication of entries in the IDJ index to include variant names due to transcription problems has been altered so that the duplications have been removed and unresolved variant names now appear in the Remarks.
- All 'Codes' indicating what is available in the Journal entries are expanded to full text.
- If in the Journal entry, the CPS [Clerk of Petty Sessions] locations have been included.
- If the ship of arrival is noted in the Journal entry, that ship name has been entered in a separate searchable field. The date of arrival has been included in the Remarks field.
- Those immigrants with the ship named have all been compared to those names on the ship list and variants of surnames, forenames and, in many cases, ages have been included in the Remarks. In many instances, the Native Place noted on the ship list if different to 'where living' in the Journal has been added to the Remarks as well.
- Accessible via the *Help* button are many Notes with links to PDF files of ★*Immigration Remittance Regulations* background ★*Ships list with arrival dates* including some unassisted lists AND a separate list containing those Ships in the supplementary records ★*Variant surname comparisons* – IDJs to Ship Lists and Ship Lists to IDJs ★*Surname Variant suggestions* ★*Illustrations*: Journal sample page; Many examples of forms used including with individuals named ★*Missed Pages*: Two double Journal pages missed in the filming.
- Fully searchable by most fields including ★*Name*: Depositor and/or Immigrant ★*Date range by year* ★*Ship* ★*Reference* ★*Remarks*; or a combination of any of these; and also by ★*Record Number* OR ★*Full Search*: searches many fields in one search.
- Search results can be ★*Sorted* and ★*Printed* or ★*Exported* in several formats such as MS Excel spreadsheet, MS Word, HTML, PDF, RTF, TIFF, XFF and Open Office Writer – PDF files are recommended to retain format.
- Compatible with Windows 98 to Windows 8/8.1. Windows 10 users need an additional system file. If the *Employment and Dispersals Lists* CD is installed on the same system, the system file would already be installed; otherwise please contact Pastkeys for a link to 'safe' system file download.
